

## **UK Modern Slavery Act**

As a company located and operating solely in the UK, LondonMetric's exposure to human rights risks – including modern forms of slavery – is very limited. LondonMetric has published its Remuneration policy which demonstrates its commitment to transparent and fair remuneration for its own employees.

However, to reduce exposure to slavery and human trafficking within its supply chain, LondonMetric specifically addresses these important areas in its Responsible Procurement Policy and Responsible Development Requirements Checklist.

LondonMetric requires its contractors to meet a number of standards including: paying a fair wage to their workers, respecting Human Rights and Labour Rights Legislation, and investigating their own supply chains for slavery and human trafficking. For each development, contractors are expected to provide, on request, evidence that they meet these requirements.

No human rights concerns have arisen within our direct operations or our supply chain.
