LONDONMETRIC ACHIEVES GRESB GREEN STAR AND

EPRA GOLD STAR AWARDS FOR SUSTAINABLE REPORTING IN 2016

LondonMetric Property Plc ("LondonMetric" or "Company") is pleased to announce that it

has been awarded a Green Star in this year's Global Real Estate Sustainability Benchmark

(GRESB) survey.

LondonMetric scored 66% in the 2016 survey, which is a significant improvement on the 34%

and 50% achieved in 2014 and 2015 respectively, and puts the Company further ahead of its

peer group average, as defined by GRESB, of 56%.

GRESB assesses the environmental, social, and governance performance of real assets

globally, including real estate portfolios, real estate debt portfolios and infrastructure.

Separately, LondonMetric has maintained its EPRA sBPR Gold Award for sustainability

reporting which it attained for the first time last year. LondonMetric is one of ten UK listed

companies to receive a Gold Award. The EPRA Sustainability Awards are based on a review

of the sustainability performance of 98 publicly listed real estate companies in the FTSE

EPRA/NAREIT Developed EMEA Index and is regarded as the industry benchmark for

sustainability reporting.

These awards further demonstrate the significant progress made over the last three years to

actively integrate Responsible Business into the Company's activities and report on its

environmental performance. The Green Star, in particular, is a major achievement and helps

LondonMetric to meet one of its key Responsible Business targets for 2016/17.
